NEW SPENCER ROAD BRANCH *Opening Summer 2011*



The St. Charles City-County Library District will replace the Spencer Road Branch with a 2 story, 54,701 sq ft building which more than doubles the space of the current branch. The new branch will be built behind the existing library at Spencer Road & Boone Hills Drive in St. Peters.

During Construction

- The library will remain open, maintaining current hours.
- All materials and services will be available to library customers
- Library programming may be limited.
- The community meeting room will NOT be available to organizations & groups beginning January 2010
- Parking for customers will be limited
- Due to safety issues, the branch may need to close for short periods during construction. Temporary closings will be posted.

Project Timeline

1. Early 2010 project bid out
2. Early 2010 demolition of the Nonprofit Development Center
3. Spring 2010 construction of new library directly behind current branch begins.
4. Summer 2011 move branch to new facility, demolish current Spencer Road Branch, construct parking area on old site
5. Summer 2011 new Spencer Road Branch opens with increased space & amenities.

New Spencer Road Branch Amenities

- Lots of comfortable seating areas
- Multiple small conference & study rooms in the library
- More meeting rooms for community organizations shared with the Community Council and nonprofit development services
- Meeting area that will accommodate nearly 300 people for large events & programs
- Training area with computers
- Additional public access PCs, including "express" stations
- Comfortable reading room with fireplace
- Outdoor plaza for seating and programs
- Twice as much parking
- More areas for use of free Wifi
- Drive up Book Drop
- Drive up Window for pick up of materials
- Separate Teen & Childrens Areas
- Upscale Business & Public Management and Nonprofit services area funded by the estate of Bob & Jackie Houck
- Opportunities for donors and naming rights

The Library District will continue to upgrade & remodel all branches throughout the County. Recent improvements include:

- Expansion & remodel of Library Express at WingHaven.
- Relocation of South County Branch in Augusta to new, larger building.
- Upgrades to service areas at Corporate Parkway and Deer Run Branches
