## FREE Wi-Fi INTERNET ACCESS

Free wireless Internet access is available now at the St. Charles City-County Library District Kathryn Linnemann Branch, 2323 Elm Street, St. Charles; Spencer Road Branch, 427 Spencer Road, St. Peters; Middendorf-Kredell Branch, 2750 Hwy. K, O'Fallon; & Library Express at WingHaven, 7435 Village Center Dr., O'Fallon.

“Customers expect to be able to use their laptops & wireless devices in public buildings,” said Library Director Carl Sandstedt. “Libraries are information providers. Wireless Internet access in our library branches is just one more way libraries make it easier for our customers get the information they want.”

### Free Wi-Fi at the library:

- Requires no plug or phone jack – just turn on your wireless device & start surfing
- May be accessed during normal library hours
- Means no waiting for an available library PC
- No enforced time limits – connect as long as you like
- Does not require a St. Charles City-County Library card
- Provides fast access to the Internet
- Allows customers to download & save files permanently on their own device

- Library District Wi-Fi is unfiltered. Users must abide by all Library District Internet use policies.
- The Library cannot guarantee the security of your wireless device or data.
- Library staff is not able to provide technical assistance.
- Printing to library printers is not available.

A laptop or wireless device with 802.11b or 802.11g wireless networking & applicable software.
